

<u>**Iacaranda**</u>

Scientific Name: Jacaranda mimosifolia

(Native to tropical and subtropical regions of Central America, South America, Cuba, Hispaniola, and the Bahamas- Most common species found in India)





Features:

- 1. It has bluish-lilac ornamental flowers, and is mainly planted for aesthetic value.
- 2. The name 'Jacaranda' is originated from Gauarani (National Language of Paraguay) meaning "fragrant". Interesting Fact-Grafton in New South Wales, Australia celebrates "Jacaranda Festival" since 1934 to celebrate the extravagant display of flowers by this tree.
